**DISBURSEMENT INFORMATION:**

The Parent PLUS MPN is designed for a parent to use as a multi-year note for one dependent student. Under the Parent PLUS MPN process, a parent borrower will sign a Parent PLUS MPN only once, at the time the parent first borrows for that dependent student. The same parent may obtain additional loans for that same student, for up to ten years after the date the parent signed the initial Parent PLUS MPN, without requiring a new promissory note.

Due to the federally required implementation of the Parent PLUS (MPN), the authorization for schools to electronically receive and transfer Parent PLUS Loan proceeds to your dependent student's WSU account is now incorporated into the borrower authorization section in item 19D on the MPN.

**I understand these proceeds will pay all required institutional charges and my student will receive any residual funds, to be used for any remaining educational expenses.**
